



Adelaide seeks more JV opportunities after National Mainstreet Award

Adelaide City Council says it wants to create more collaborative projects such as the Maras Group JV which won a prestigious National Mainstreet Australia Award this week.

The National Mainstreet Australia Private Sector Partnership Award recognized the upgrade and revamp of the south side of Rundle Street East in 2010-11.

"It's a great example of what can be achieved with cross-collaboration and team-work between Council and the private-sector," says Lord Mayor Stephen Yarwood. "We're really keen to foster more partnerships like this with organisations and individuals for the benefit of the whole community."

The project involved Council's improvement of the southern footpath and public realm which included repaving, landscaping and footpath widening which made way for extended outdoor dining areas, additional public seating and increased accessibility for pedestrians and traders.

Maras Group upgraded all of its buildings along the south side of Rundle Street East with new design elements and features and an impressive redecorating project which "significantly elevated the profile of the main street".

Steve Maras won the top honour of National Mainstreet Champion.
