

Burger Theory gets a shopfront

POPULAR street food operator Burger Theory will establish its first bricks and mortar shop in a new multi-million dollar building approaching completion off Rundle St.

Rob Dean and Dan Mendelson, the men behind Burger Theory, will return to the Ebenezer Place site where it all started for them in 2011.

On a then-empty block of land, the pair set up their US-style burger van.

In April, they are set to open their first permanent shop on the ground level of a six-storey office building being developed by Maras Group.

"We're going to have a bigger kitchen so we'll be able to better cater for vegetarians and offer gluten free," Mr Dean said, adding that the burger van would continue to operate.

Further east from Ebenezer Place on Rundle St, Melbourne-based chocolate cafe Chocolateria San Churro will also open its first Adelaide store.
